Inspect smoke and carbon monoxide detectors Ensure all smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are in good condition and have working batteries.
Inspect your fire sprinkler system Have your sprinkler system professionally inspected to verify that it is in good working order.
Notify tenants about the start of heat season Let your tenants know that heat season has begun.
Make sure heat is set to the correct temperatures as per the law 68 degrees F between 6 AM and 10 pm (when the temperature is below 55 F) and 62 degrees F between 10 pm and 6 Am.
Make sure your water is maintaining at temperature of 120 degrees F.
Asses your roof's ability to withstand a winter storm
Inspect your parapets Have all parapets inspected and maintain clear records of the inspection.
Inspect boilers & water heaters Have all high-pressure water boilers inspected twice annually.
Inspect fire pumps Check that your properties' fire pumps are operating effectively.
Have an energy audit performed Have a professional perform an energy audit on your building and submit the EER to the DOB.
Drain & close your irrigation sprinkler system
